

Dedicated buses for riders & bikes for Geelong - Melbourne

Because of essential rail works on 18 October train services will be suspended between Geelong and Newport.

Regular commuters will have access to a replacement bus service provided by Connex and V/Line, but in accordance with the Victorian Fares and Ticketing Manual 2009, bicycles are not permitted to travel on those buses.

This would have created considerable inconvenience to those cyclists who decided to withdraw in Geelong from the Around The Bay in a Day® 2009 event on 18 October.

As a consequence Connex have kindly agreed to provide a dedicated bus service for participants and their bikes.

The dedicated event buses will run from the official rest areas located at Rippleside Park, Geelong, BP Service Station, Little River, and Kelly Park, Werribee.

The buses will connect to Newport Station, where cyclists can interchange to connecting train services at Newport Station to continue their journey. Buses will run every hour from 10am with the last bus leaving Rippleside Park, Geelong at 4.00pm.
