



## Conditions of Ticket Sale

By purchasing a ticket to "Shannon Noll Live, Presented by Mitchelton Wines" ("**concert**") organised and promoted by Bicycle Victoria ("**organisers**"), you accept and agree to be bound by the following terms and conditions:

1. You must hold a valid ticket for the concert that must be presented at the time of entry to gain access to the concert. If you hold a valid ticket for the concert and are under 18 years of age, you must be accompanied by a parent or guardian to gain access to the concert.
2. The concert is licensed and alcoholic beverages will be available for purchase and consumption at the concert. You must be aged 18 years or over to purchase and/or consume alcohol at the concert and current, valid photographic identification (such as a driver's licence or passport) will be requested and must be produced at the time that alcohol is purchased. If you are aged under 18 years and you attempt to purchase, purchase, consume or are in possession of alcohol at the concert, you will be removed from the concert and you may face charges.
3. The organisers support and promote the responsible consumption of alcohol by persons aged 18 years of age and over. The organisers or any employees or officials representing them reserve the right, in their absolute discretion, to refuse to sell or serve alcohol to you or remove you from the concert if they determine it appropriate to do so.
4. No bottles, glass, cans, alcohol (except alcohol purchased at the concert), drugs or weapons of any kind will be permitted at the concert. You and any bags and containers in your possession will be searched prior to entry to the concert and the organisers reserve the right, in their absolute discretion, to refuse entry to, or remove you from, the concert if you are in possession of any prohibited or suspicious item or substance.
5. You are not permitted to record, film, tape, photograph or broadcast the concert in any manner whatsoever.
6. You must remain within the designated concert area at all times during the concert and you must follow any instructions given to you by the organisers or any employees or officials representing the organisers at the concert. Failure to do so may result in you being removed from the concert.
7. The organisers are not liable to you for any loss, damage, cost or expense of any kind, including but not limited to, the refund of the cost of your ticket, if you are denied access to or removed from the concert for any reason.
8. You attend the concert at your own risk and the organisers are not responsible for or liable to you for any injury, loss, damage, cost or expense you may suffer or incur as a result of your attendance at the concert, regardless of the manner in which that injury, loss, damage, cost or expense is suffered or incurred by you.
9. The concert will be held outdoors and will proceed notwithstanding poor weather conditions on the day of the concert. The organisers are not liable to you for any loss, damage, cost or expense of any kind including, but not limited to, the refund of the cost of your ticket, in the concert of poor weather before or during the concert.
10. The organisers reserve the right, in their absolute discretion, to:
  - (a) change, vary or substitute artists performing at the concert from those named in advertising material and on tickets for the concert; or
  - (b) cancel, postpone, reschedule or change the time or place for the concert for any reason and at any time prior to the commencement of the concert, and

The organisers are not responsible for or liable to you for any loss, damage, cost or expense, whether direct, indirect, consequential or otherwise and howsoever or wheresoever incurred by you resulting from any such action taken by the organisers.

11. The organisers will not replace any tickets that are lost, misplaced or destroyed before the concert.
12. No unauthorised on selling of tickets is permitted and the organisers reserve the right, in their absolute discretion, to cancel any tickets for the concert purchased in such manner.
13. Concert Tickets will not be refunded. Once the ticket is purchased, the ticket remains the property of the buyer and will be distributed to the buyer at the allocated time.
