### 5. Student Leadership

- Ask your Student Representative Council to take on the event planning.
- Invite interested students to nominate themselves for the task.
- Groups can brainstorm some ideas for the day. These might include ideas for promotion, sponsorship, a special assembly, guest speakers, bike storage, media, etc.
- Give students this resource CD to use and set them completion dates
- Assign tasks to sub-groups or individuals
- Students can report back to the group on their progress in completing their assigned tasks. Organised this way, everything will get done without leaving it to the last minute or up to one person.

Your school will have its own ideas about facilitating student leadership, event planning and public speaking. Hopefully these ideas will help inspire you to inspire your students into leadership roles.
